1 50 g. Ball Bernat Handicrafter Cotton (or any medium weight cotton) Soft Violet was used in this pattern.

1 140 g. Ball Bernat Softee Baby Yarn
Soft Lilac was used in this pattern.

1 Pair 3.75 mm / U.S. #5 needles

1 Circular needle size 4.5 mm / U.S. #7

2 dome or velcro fastener

Gauge for Cotton and 3.75 mm needles:
4 inches square = 20 stitches by 28 rows

Sized for 6 mos.

Bottice

Back

Using the cotton cast on 50 sts. Knit in stocking stitch until back measures 5 inches. Ending on a ws row. Knit 25 sts. Cast on 3 sts. Slip remaining 25 sts. onto a stitch holder.

Working the 28 sts. work in stocking stitch until back measures 6.25 inches from beginning. Cast off these 28 sts.

Pick up and knit the 25 sts on the holder until back measures 6.25 inches from beginning. Cast off.

Front

Using the cotton cast on 50 sts. Knit in stocking stitch until measures 5 inches from beginning. Ending with ws row. Knit 15 sts. Cast off 20 sts. Knit remaining 15 sts.

Purl 15 sts. Continue working these 15 sts. in stocking stitch until piece measures 6.25 from beginning. Cast these 15 sts. off.

Knit the remaining 15 sts. until this side measures 6.25 inches from the beginning. Cast off.

Sleeves

Using the cotton cast on 36 sts.

Increase as follows:

1st row: Knit

2nd row: Purl

3rd row: K1, increase 1 st, Knit to last 1 st, increase 1 st, K 1

4th row: Purl

Continue these 4 rows until you 46 sts. Cast off. Make one more sleeve.

Sew Bottice and Sleeves together.

Skirt

With Softee Baby yarn and circular needles pick 100 sts along the bottom edge of the bottice. Knit 1 round. Purl 1 round. Next round *K4, increase 1* Repeat ** to end of round (125 sts.).

Purl 1 round

Knit 1 round

Repeat these two rounds until skirt is 8.5 inches long. Cast off in Picot edge (see good knit tips page for help). Finish off by crocheting picot edge around neck line and sleeves. Add fastners on back of bottice.
