

Hat, Mitts and Scarf Pompom Set



Scarf

- 1 Ball worsted acrylic yarn 198 g ball main color (2 balls should be enough for entire set)
- 1 Ball contrast color same type of yarn (1 ball should be enough for entire set)
- 1 Pair 5.5 mm / U.S. #9 needles

Gauge:
Not important for a scarf.

Cast on 50 sts. Double rib (p2, k2) for 44 inches. Cast off.

Make 10 pompoms and sew 5 equally across each side.

Mittens

- 1 Ball worsted acrylic yarn 198 g ball main color
 - 1 Ball contrast color same type of yarn (can use from scarf)
 - 1 Pair Double Pointed needles size 5 mm/ U.S. #
- Sized for ages 2-3 approximately.

Gauge: 4 sts per inch

Cast on 20 sts. with contrast color. Place marker at beginning of round. Change to main color and rib (k1, p1) for 2 inches.

Knit 4 rounds.

Thumb gusset:

1st rnd: K1, inc.1, K19, inc.1

2nd rnd: Knit

3rd rnd: K2, inc.1, K19, inc.1, K1

4th rnd: Knit

5th rnd: K3, inc.1, K19, inc.1, K2

6th rnd: Knit

7th rnd: K4, inc.1, K19, inc.1, K3

8th rnd: Knit

9th rnd: K5, inc.1, K19, inc.1, K4

Knit the next 6 sts. Put the next 20 sts. on waste yarn. 10 sts. left on 2 needles. Distribute as evenly on 3 needles. K1 rnd, knitting 2 sts. together at the base of the thumb. Knit until thumb measures 2 to 2.5 inches (longer for older child).

Decrease for the thumb:

K2tog. repeat to end. Cut a long tail of yarn and put through stitches. Sew up thumb with tail of yarn.

Pick up sts on waste yarn and place a marker at the beginning of the round. Knit 1 round increasing by 1 st at the beginning of the round. Place another marker between the 10th st and the 11th st. (20 sts all together).

Knit until mitten is 5.5 or 6 inches (depending on the child) from the beginning of the ribbing.

Decrease for top of mitten:

1st rnd: K1, dec.1, K to 3 sts before marker, dec. 1, K2, dec. 1,
K to 3 sts before marker, dec. 1, K1

2nd rnd: Knit

Repeat these two rounds until 10 sts remain. Sew top together or pull thread through the sts.

Hat

1 Ball worsted acrylic yarn 198 g ball main color

1 Ball contrast color same type of yarn (can use from scarf)

1 Pair Double Pointed needles size 5 mm/ U.S. #

Sized for ages 2-3 approximately.

Gauge: 4 sts per inch

Cast on 72 sts in contrast color. Place marker at beginning of round. Change to main color and rib for 3 inches. Knit in stocking st in main color until hat measures 6.5 inches from beginning (includes ribbing).

Decrease as follows:

Rnd 1 *K2tog, k3, repeat * to end of rnd. 56 sts remain

Rnd 2 Knit

Rnd 3 *K2tog, K2, repeat* to end of rnd. 42 sts remain

Rnd 4 Knit

Rnd 5 *K2tog, K1, repeat* to end of rnd. 28 sts remain

Rnd 6 Knit

Rnd 7 *K2tog, repeat* to end of rnd. 14 sts remain

Rnd 8 Knit

Rnd 9 same as rnd 7

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail pull through remaining sts and weave in. Create a large pom pom in contrast color and sew on.
