



DR. WHO COWL

Originally I knit a full length 4th Doctor Who scarf but it can be impractical at times. This cowl is practical and reflects the look of the 4th Doctor's full length scarf.

DIFFICULTY - EASY

MATERIALS

Pattern uses Patons Classic Wool in Worsted weight. Each ball is 192 m/210 yards, 100 g / 3.5 oz. You'll have left over yarn.

Royal Purple	Bright Red
Natural Mix	Aran
Yellow	Mercury
Jade Heather	

1 Pair 4.5 mm / U.S. #7 needles

GAUGE

4 inches square in garter stitch = 32 stitches by 40 rows.

Cowl will measure 6.5 inches wide by 32 inches long before sewn together.

DIRECTIONS

Cast on 52 sts.

Slip the first stitch at the beginning of each row (this gives you a nice, straight edge). Knit every row following these colours.

36 rows Royal Purple
8 rows Bright Red
34 rows Natural Mix
8 rows Royal Purple
16 rows Aran
14 rows Yellow
8 rows Bright Red
24 rows Mercury
14 rows Aran
10 rows Royal Purple
20 rows Natural Mix
10 rows Yellow
14 rows Jade Heather



16 rows Bright Red
12 rows Jade Heather

Bind off. Weave in ends. Block and sew the bind off edge to the cast on edge.
